

South Africa 2018 – Code of conduct

(Draft)

A *Participation and attitude:*

1. Be supportive, respectful and considerate towards everyone in the group.
2. Listen to the staff and follow their instructions.
3. Be open to new experiences and willing to join in all activities.
4. Be punctual for all meetings.

B *Safety:*

1. Never go anywhere without staff permission, and always stay in groups of three or more.
2. Do not take valuables out with you unless they are needed.
3. Make use of the safety deposit boxes in the hotel for storing valuables.
4. Keep a close eye on your personal belongings when out and about. Think about how you are carrying your stuff and never leave it unattended unless you have been shown a safe place for storage.
5. Take water and sunscreen with you at all times.
6. Do not speak to strangers unless a teacher is present.
7. Do not get any new tattoos or piercings.

C *In the hotel:*

1. Do not leave the hotel unless accompanied by a teacher.
2. Keep noise levels at a reasonable level in the rooms and do not slam doors.
3. Keep room doors closed and check who is knocking before you open the door.
4. Be in your own room at room check.
5. Only in an emergency are you allowed to leave your room after curfew time.

D *At the beach:*

1. No swimming.
2. Do not take valuables to the beach and never leave personal belongings unattended.
3. Do not leave our designated area without permission from a member of staff.

E *Alcohol consumption:*

1. Consumption of alcohol is not permitted on this trip at any point. This is regardless of your age.

F *Dress code:*

1. Wear hoodies and JGHS t-shirts when instructed.
2. Smart/casual clothing for school visits (t-shirts or loose fitting shirts).
 - o Trousers/skirts/shorts must all be knee length or below.
3. No low cut tops or belly tops.
