- S5 activity (1 period this replaces core RME)

These will automatically be added to your timetable.



You will need to choose **5 subjects** from the table below.

This should be at the appropriate level e.g: Higher/ Level 6 English if you are on course to pass Nat. 5/ level 5/ English, Nat. 5/ level 5 Biology if you are presented for Nat. 4/ level 4 Biology in S4 etc.



SCHOOL COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To choose a subject at Higher/level 6 in S5, pupils must meet the entry requirements. Pupils who are not on track to achieve this will be advised to choose an alternative subject by their Pupil Support Leader at their individual coursing discussion conducted during January 2025. PSLs will use attainment tracking and evidence of progress when discussing appropriate courses.

Entry requirements for a Higher/level 6 course of study are:

- Grade A or B at National 5/Level 5 in the same or closely related subject (e.g. For H Engineering Science, A or B at N5 Physics would be considered)
- Grade C will be considered on an individual basis after consultation with your PSL and the Curricular Leader.

Grade D or lower <u>will not be permitted</u> entry to a Higher/level 6 course of study due to the increased challenge at this level.

- Please thoroughly research the content and detail for each course in Section 4 of this booklet.
- You must ensure you have met the entry requirements before choosing your courses.
- You must let your PSL know if you are considering leaving school at the end of this academic session. (May 2025)
- Course choices will be made using the online system TOOLS your PSL will enter your subject choices into this after a coursing discussion with you.
- Deadline for course choice is **Friday 21st February 2025.** If you do not submit choices by then, you may be allocated subjects not of your own choosing.

Please note that the school may need to amend or remove any of the courses listed below due to pupil uptake or staffing capacity. If this occurs, reserve subjects will be used.
