James Gillespie's High School has several ways of making sure every pupil is ready to learn each day.

Breakfast Club

Anyone can come to Breakfast Club! It is to help ensure pupils have a nutritious breakfast and feel ready for the day to come.

It runs from **07:45 until 08:30** every school day and it is completely **free**.



Universal provision of stationery

Every classroom in JGHS will have a dedicated drawer with pens, pencils, erasers and sharpeners for anyone who needs them.

Pupils can use it for during class and return it at the end.

School trip funding

The school will provide help with the cost of trips/activities for families who experience financial hardship or who may, for some reason, not be able to pay for them.



Free online shop - circular economy!

A new universal support through which any member of the school community can donate or "purchase", free of charge, donated goods such as revision guides and books, clothes and school bags.



Access to Success

We offer academic support for S1-4 pupils who may not be achieving their full potential. Priority is given to pupils in receipt of Free School Meals or struggling financially.

Sources of support

- Free School Meals families on low income can get help with the cost of lunches. We highly recommend you apply for FSM.
- **EMA** Education Maintenance Allowance gives support to eligible 16-19 year olds who want to continue learning (£30/week).
- **Scottish Child Payment** helps towards the costs of supporting your family (£26.70/week for every child).
- CHAI Community Help & Advice initiative supports and empowers people and communities across Edinburgh through free, confidential, high-quality, impartial advice, information and representation on welfare benefits, money, housing and employability.
